Magali and Thibaut Decoster own this 4.5ha property that is quietly getting better and better. Not as complex as their Clos des Jacobins, but this is still a lovely St Emilion, with blueberry and cassis fruits, firm tannins and clear austerity that will soften over the next three to four years.

DECANTER - *Georgina HINDLE* - février 2022

Quite closed on the nose. This is a cooler style with blue and dark fruit notes apparent on the nose and palate, with some liquorice and wood spice. Quite a restrained style, feels a little closed right now, not offering much exuberance or expression. Texture is lovely and smooth, and you can feel the depth on the mid-palate but it's not shining. Good length and a menthol, cooling lift at the end.

THE DRINKS BUSINESS - *Colin HAY* - *juillet 2020* - Primeurs

(roughly 70% Merlot; 30% Cabernet Franc). Tasted from a sample supplied by the chateau. Again, like Clos des Jacobins, big, very dark in the glass and extracted. Almost opaque. Garnet/ black. Deep dark rich fruit. Chocolate, hints of coal and the smoke from a bonfire. Bramble compote; black cherries. Plush and plump tannins. Soft attack but a rather disguised fruit – a melange of rather generic black fruits. A bit confected; lacks definition. Harsh tannins. Over- extracted and over-worked for my taste. Little of the signature freshness of the vintage.

THE WINE DOCTOR - *Chris KISSACK* - *juin 2020* - Primeurs

91-93/100

From an estate close to Château Ripeau and Château Jean Faure, this is 75% Merlot and 25% Cabernet Franc, with 14.5% alcohol. A dark and glossy hue in the glass, while the nose presents aromas of lightly smudged and baked fruits, grilled blackberry and black plum, with a scented, rose-petal perfume. The palate shows a very elegant start, richly textured and yet well framed, with finely polished fruit pushing through the middle of the palate, dark and tightly grained, with blackcurrant, black cherry, vanilla pod and cocoa bean flavours, as well as a little edge of floral perfume. The structure is ripe, svelte and deeply buried, with a cool and fresh acid thread running beneath it all. Rather a firm grip of tannins at the end, quite substantial in truth, with a long grip. A good wine, albeit with rather a smudged, modern feel. From my Bordeaux 2019 primeurs assessment

The 2019 La Commanderie has an opulent bouquet with lavish black and blueberry fruit, a little oaky but undeniably very seductive. It does not overwhelm the senses. The palate is medium-bodied with sappy black fruit, fine acidity, multi-layered with a grippy, lightly spiced finish. I think this underwent maximum but not excessive extraction and therefore constitutes a well-crafted Saint-Émilion packed with ageing potential. Tasted twice. 2024-2042
